**Chap. 442.** AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE PAYABLE UNDER THE STATE-BOSTON RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO VICTOR STASHEWSKY BECAUSE OF INJURIES SUSTAINED IN LINE OF DUTY AS A POLICE OFFICER OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

For the purpose of promoting the public good, the accidental disability retirement allowance payable under section seven of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws to Victor Stashewsky, who is totally and permanently incapacitated as a result of injuries sustained by him when shot on July fourteenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, while making an arrest in the performance of his duty as a police officer of the city of Boston, shall include such yearly amount of additional pension as will make such retirement allowance from and after the effective date of this act at all times equal to the annual rate of regular compensation which would have been payable to him by said city had he continued in service in the grade held by him at the time of his retirement, anything in paragraph (c) of subdivision (2) of said section seven to the contrary notwithstanding. The provisions of section one hundred B of chapter forty-one of the General Laws shall apply to said Victor Stashewsky as if a person retired under a special law applicable to one person were not excepted therefrom.

**Chap. 443.** AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT, TO PROVIDE FOR SUPPLEMENTING CERTAIN EXISTING APPROPRIATIONS AND FOR CERTAIN NEW ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain appropriations previously made and for certain new activities and projects, the sums set forth in this act are hereby made available from the funds designated, to be in addition to any amounts otherwise available for the purpose, subject to the provisions of law regulating the disbursement of public funds and the approval thereof and the conditions pertaining to the appropriations in chapter four hundred and fourteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
