Chap. 461. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE POSITION OF PARKING METER SUPERVISOR IN CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 780 of the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 55, the words "Parking meter supervisors" and inserting in place thereof the words:— Parking meter supervisors, except as provided in section forty-eight B.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 31 is hereby further amended by inserting after section 48A the following section:—

Section 48B. A city, by vote of its city council, and a town, by vote of its town meeting, may place the position of parking meter supervisor under the provisions of this chapter.

Chap. 462. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF ANNUITIES TO A VETERAN SUFFERING FROM THE LOSS OF BOTH LEGS DUE TO A SERVICE CONNECTED DISABILITY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 6B of chapter 115 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 567 of the acts of 1956, is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:—
