

Chap. 655. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ENTRANCE OF MANAGEMENT INTERNS INTO THE OFFICIAL SERVICE OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND IN CERTAIN POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS THEREOF.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 8B the following section: —

Section 8C. Once each year, or more often if the director determines that the public convenience so requires, the director shall hold a competitive examination, except as provided in section twenty open to citizens of the United States, wherever they may reside, who, at the time of such examination, have completed, or expect to complete within nine months, a four-year course leading to a bachelor's degree in an accredited college or university, or have any combination of education and experience in administrative, professional or investigative work acceptable to the director.

The form, method and subject matter of such examination shall be determined from time to time by the director. Notice of the examination shall take such form and be given in such manner and at such time or times as the director shall determine; and the director shall likewise determine when applications for the examination shall be received.

Following each such examination, the director shall establish an eligible list containing the names of all persons who passed such examination and he shall place such names in the order specified by section twenty-three. Such list shall be open to public inspection. Each applicant shall be notified promptly of the results of his examination.

Certification from any such list shall be made by the director only to fill vacancies in offices or positions in the official service of the commonwealth and its subdivisions for which, with the approval of the commission, he determines the examination to have been appropriate and only upon request of the appointing authority for certification from such list.

Chap. 656. AN ACT ALLOWING THE NORTH ADAMS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION TO ISSUE BONDS WITHOUT ANY INTEREST LIMITATION ON THE PAYMENT OF SUCH BONDS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 3 of chapter 548 of the acts of 1953 is hereby amended by striking out the seventh sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — The commission may sell such bonds in such manner, either at public or private sale, and for such price as it may determine to be for the best interest of the commission.

Chap. 657. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WINCHENDON TO ERECT A TOWN GARAGE TO BE USED BY ITS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS ON LAND OWNED BY THE TOWN AND BEING PART OF A PUBLIC DOMAIN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:
