Chap. 729. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LOWELL AND TOWN OF TEWKSBURY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE TIE-IN TO THE LOWELL SEWAGE SYSTEM OF A CERTAIN SCHOOL SEWAGE SYSTEM IN SAID TEWKSBURY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Tewksbury may enter into an agreement with the city of Lowell for the tie-in of the sewage system of a certain new school in North Tewksbury to the Lowell sewage system for the purpose of disposing of the waste and sewage of said school, provided that the said town shall not tie-in any other facility thereto and provided, further, that the said town shall pay all expenses of installation and maintenance thereof.

SECTION 2. The said agreement upon the election of said city or town shall expire upon the construction and operation of a town sewage system or a sewage treatment plant.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 730. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SALEM TO PAY TO THE WIDOW OF JAMES W. DOLAN, A FORMER MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, WHO DIED IN OFFICE, THE BALANCE OF HIS SALARY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

For the purpose of promoting the public good, the city of Salem is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay to the widow of James W. Dolan, who died while a member of the present city council of said city, the balance of the salary to which he would have been entitled for the current term for which he was elected had he lived and continued to serve in said council until the end of said term.

Chap. 731. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PLACEMENT OF FIRE INSURANCE IN CERTAIN URBAN AREAS.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith for the placement of basic property insurance coverage of residential and business properties through the cooperative efforts of insurance companies licensed to write such insurance in the commonwealth, therefore it is hereby
