

Chap. 743. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE STATE OFFICE BUILDING AS THE LEVERETT SALTONSTALL BUILDING.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The state office building in the government center in the city of Boston shall be known and designated as the Leverett Saltonstall Building in recognition of the long and meritorious public service of former governor and United States senator Leverett Saltonstall. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached to said building by the state superintendent of buildings, who shall provide for appropriate ceremonies to be held in connection therewith.

Chap. 744. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE GROUPING OF PRECINCTS AT PRELIMINARY ELECTIONS AND SPECIAL CITY ELECTIONS IN THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 280 of the acts of 1932 is hereby amended by inserting after section 16A, inserted by section 5 of chapter 611 of the acts of 1958, the following section: —

Section 16B. The city council may by vote determine upon the holding of a preliminary election or special city election by wards, precincts or groups of precincts. Such determination shall be made at a meeting held no later than the sixtieth day before the affected preliminary election or special city election, and notice thereof in writing shall be given forthwith to the city clerk and the board of registrars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 745. AN ACT INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD OF MANAGERS OF THE QUINCY CITY HOSPITAL AND PROVIDING THAT SAID BOARD SHALL APPOINT THE DIRECTOR OF SAID HOSPITAL FOR A TERM OF YEARS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 134 of the Special Acts of 1919 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 10, the word "five" and inserting in place thereof the word: — nine.

SECTION 2. The mayor of the city of Quincy shall appoint the four additional members of the board of managers of the Quincy City Hospital, provided for in section one of this act, for terms expiring on the first Monday of January in the first, second, third and fourth years following the effective date of this act, and thereafter, as the term of any such member expires, the mayor of said city shall appoint a successor for a term of five years, from the first Monday of January in the year of appointment.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the board of managers of the Quincy City Hospital shall appoint
