

Legion Post No. 66 Memorial bridge. Suitable markers bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works in compliance with the standards of said department and as authorized by the federal bureau of public roads. *Approved March 14, 1969.*

Chap. 83. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN ASSISTANT CLERKS OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF HAMPSHIRE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section two of chapter two hundred and seventy-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, any person appointed to the office of an assistant clerk of the district court of Hampshire between June fifteenth and December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, both dates inclusive, shall receive such salary as is provided by section seventy-nine and section eighty of chapter two hundred and eighteen of the General Laws, said salary to be effective as of the date of his said appointment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 84. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT COMPENSATION PAID TO POLICE OFFICERS AND FIRE FIGHTERS FOR HOLIDAY SERVICE SHALL BE INCLUDED AS REGULAR COMPENSATION FOR DEDUCTION PURPOSES TOWARD RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted, etc , as follows:

The paragraph defining "Regular Compensation" in section 1 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting before the last sentence the following sentence: — In the case of police officers and fire fighters, money paid for service rendered on holidays shall be regarded as regular compensation rather than as overtime and shall be included in the salary on which deductions are to be paid to the annuity savings fund

Chap. 85. AN ACT AUTHORIZING SCHOOL COMMITTEES TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER SCHOOL COMMITTEES INVOLVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR INNOVATIVE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND SUPPLEMENTARY EDUCATION CENTERS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The first paragraph of section 4A of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 286 of the acts of 1966, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "forty-four", in line 9, the words: — , or the expenditure of funds for establishing supplementary education centers and innovative educational programs. *Approved March 18, 1969.*
