

Chap. 274. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HOLYOKE TO USE CERTAIN PARK LAND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW FIRE STATION.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The city of Holyoke is hereby authorized to transfer a certain parcel of land from its parks and recreation department to its board of public works for the purpose of constructing a new fire station thereon, bounded and described as follows: —

Beginning at a point on the westerly side of Northampton street, said point being 121.48 feet southerly from the southerly side of Easthampton road; thence N 83° 20' 30" W a distance of 120.00 feet to a point; thence S 88° 01' 27" W a distance of 137.00 feet to a point; thence N 1° 58' 33" W a distance of 99.41 feet to a point on the aforesaid southerly side of Easthampton road; thence N 88° 01' 27" E along said side of Easthampton road a distance of 202.29 feet to a point; thence southeasterly along the arc of a 65.00 foot radius curve, a distance of 118.95 feet to a point on the westerly side of aforesaid Northampton street; thence S 12° 52' 30" W a distance of 37.00 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel contains 24,443 square feet, more or less.

Chap. 275. AN ACT CLARIFYING THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE RECEIVER TO THE SENDER OF UNSOLICITED GOODS BY MAIL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section: —

Section 43. Any person who receives unsolicited goods, wares or merchandise, offered for sale, but not actually ordered or requested by him orally or in writing, shall be entitled to consider such goods, wares or merchandise an unconditional gift, and he may use or dispose of the same as he sees fit without obligation on his part to the sender.

Chap. 276. AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF WAGES WHICH SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM ATTACHMENT BY TRUSTEE PROCESS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The first sentence of section 28 of chapter 246 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 187 of the acts of 1959, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 3, the word "fifty" and inserting in place thereof the word: — eighty.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, nineteen hundred and seventy and shall apply only to actions begun on and after said date.
