

grantee and a recital of the amount of the full consideration thereof in dollars or the nature of the other consideration therefor, if not delivered for a specific monetary sum. The full consideration shall mean the total price for the conveyance without deduction for any liens or encumbrances assumed by the grantee or remaining thereon. All such endorsements and recitals shall be recorded as part of the deed. Failure to comply with this section shall not affect the validity of any deed. No register of deeds shall accept a deed for recording unless it is in compliance with the requirements of this section.

Chap. 498. AN ACT EXEMPTING FOLK AND SQUARE DANCING FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE SUNDAY LAWS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 136 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 2, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 616 of the acts of 1962, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

Section 2. Whoever on Sunday is present at or engages in dancing, except folk or square dancing, or any game, sport, fair, exposition, play, entertainment or public diversion for which a charge in the form of the payment or collection of money or other valuable consideration is made for the privilege of being present thereat or engaging therein, and for which a license has not been granted, as provided in section four, shall be punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars.

Chap. 499. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BERKSHIRE COUNTY TO USE THE POSTWAR REHABILITATION FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMODELING, ALTERING OR RENOVATING THE BASEMENT OF THE COURT HOUSE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF CENTRAL BERKSHIRE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The county commissioners of Berkshire county are hereby authorized to sell the bonds held in the postwar rehabilitation fund of said county, established under the provisions of chapter five of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-three, and to use the proceeds thereof to remodel, alter and renovate the basement of the court house of the district court of central Berkshire for the purpose of providing suitable office space for county offices.

Chap. 500. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MARBLEHEAD TO CONSTRUCT, RECONSTRUCT, RESURFACE AND REPAIR CERTAIN PRIVATE WAYS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The town of Marblehead may construct, reconstruct, resurface and repair any private way in said town which has been used by the public for fifty years or more, provided that all owners of land
