

Chap. 569. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE TREASURER TO RECEIVE THE PRINCIPAL OF CERTAIN FUNDS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 10 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 17A, the following section: —

Section 17B. The state treasurer may receive the principal of any funds given or bequeathed to the commonwealth or to any department, office, commission, board or institution where there is no specific statutory authority to receive said fund; provided, however, that acceptance of said fund shall be subject to the approval of the governor. Upon request of the agency the state treasurer shall, subject to appropriation, expend the income of the fund, and such parts of the principal as may be subject to the control of the agency, in such manner as the agency may direct, subject to any condition affecting the administration thereof. Such funds shall be invested safely by the state treasurer, and he shall be responsible for the faithful management of the same to the same extent that he is responsible for other funds held by him.

Chap. 570. AN ACT EXEMPTING CHAPLAINS AT STATE INSTITUTIONS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE, TENURE, LEGAL HOLIDAY, WORK HOURS AND OVERTIME LAWS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 9D the following section: —

Section 9E. No person employed as a chaplain by the commonwealth shall be classified under chapter thirty-one or be subject to the provisions of sections nine A, nine B, nine D, or twenty-four A of chapter thirty, or sections thirty A or thirty B of chapter one hundred and forty-nine.

Chap. 571. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF MENTAL HEALTH TO SELL AND CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM TO THE SOUTH MIDDLESEX REGIONAL VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL SCHOOL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The commissioner of mental health, in the name and on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to sell and convey, by a deed approved as to form by the attorney general, to the South Middlesex Regional Vocational Technical School District, for the purpose of enabling said district to establish and maintain a regional vocational school thereon, a certain parcel of land located at the corner of Fountain and Winter streets in the town of Framingham, and bounded and described as follows:

Southerly by Fountain street, nine hundred seventy-five and 15/100 feet (975.15) more or less;

Westerly by Winter street, nine hundred ninety and 00/100 feet (990) more or less;
