

Northerly by land of the commonwealth of Massachusetts, eleven hundred ninety and 00/100 feet (1190) more or less;

Easterly by other land of the commonwealth of Massachusetts, and by land of the town of Framingham, eleven hundred fifty and 00/100 feet (1150) more or less;

Southeasterly on a curve by land of the town of Framingham and Fountain street, sixty-six and 54/100 feet (66.54) more or less.

Containing twenty-seven and 80/100 acres (27.80) more or less.

Meaning and intending to convey a portion of the premises conveyed to the commonwealth by the United States of America by deed dated January 4, 1955 and more specifically a portion of Parcel 3 as described in the aforementioned deed duly recorded with South Middlesex Registry of Deeds in Book 8387, Page 236.

In the event that the construction of said regional vocational school is not begun on the land hereby authorized to be conveyed within three years from the effective date of this act, title to said land shall revert to the commonwealth.

The aforementioned parcel of land shall not be conveyed by the commonwealth to said district unless said district first obtains a waiver of the applicable restrictions relative to the conveyance of said land imposed upon the commonwealth by the United States of America.

SECTION 2. Chapter six hundred and eighty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-five, as amended by chapter two hundred and forty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, is hereby repealed.

Chap. 572. AN ACT EXEMPTING GREENHOUSES LOCATED IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS FROM CERTAIN ZONING ORDINANCES AND BY-LAWS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The last sentence of section 5 of chapter 40A of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 340 of the acts of 1962, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 8 and 9, the words "except greenhouses located in residential areas".

Chap. 573. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE WOODS HOLE, MARTHA'S VINEYARD AND NANTUCKET STEAMSHIP AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE FERRY SERVICE BETWEEN HYANNIS, NANTUCKET AND MARTHA'S VINEYARD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 16 of chapter 701 of the acts of 1960 is hereby amended by striking out the last paragraph, added by chapter 413 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

The Authority may, in its discretion, provide ferry runs or such transportation annually from May first to September thirtieth to and from the port of New Bedford, via the port of Woods Hole to and from said islands, and may also provide such ferry service from May first to September thirtieth to and from inner Lewis Bay, in the town of Barnstable, to and from the islands of Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket, and may acquire any business enterprise necessary or convenient for such purposes.
