

nurse who becomes a registered nurse may be paid an increased salary rate on account of such promotion, subject to approval by the county personnel board, and a person may receive an increased cash salary in lieu of maintenance formerly received, with like approval.

Moneys appropriated under this act for the purchase of equipment shall be expended for the purposes specified in the schedules as approved by the joint committee on counties and for no other purpose.

No moneys appropriated under this act shall be expended by county officers or employees for monthly telephone service furnished to such officers or employees at places other than regular county offices.

Chap. 590. AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN SWIMMING POOL IN THE CITY OF FITCHBURG AS THE GUSTAV A. "SWEDE" JOHNSON SWIMMING POOL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The swimming pool being constructed in the city of Fitchburg by the department of public works shall, upon its completion, be known and designated as the Gustav A. "Swede" Johnson swimming pool in memory of Gustav A. Johnson who was prominent for his work with the youth of said city. A suitable marker bearing such designation shall be attached thereto in a conspicuous place by the department of natural resources.

Chap. 591. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF MENTAL HEALTH TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN LAND OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM TO TRINITY MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION, INC.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The commissioner of mental health, in the name and on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to sell and convey, by a deed approved as to form by the attorney general, to Trinity Mental Health Association, Inc., a corporation organized under chapter one hundred and eighty of the General Laws, a certain parcel of land located on

Dudley road in the town of Framingham, bounded and described as follows:—

Northerly, by land of the commonwealth, approximately 790 feet; Northeasterly by Dudley road, approximately 775 feet; Southeasterly, by a way known as Park road, approximately 1019 feet; and Westerly, by other land of the commonwealth, 1000 feet more or less.

Meaning and intending to sell and convey a portion of the premises conveyed to the commonwealth by the United States of America by deed dated January 4, 1955 and recorded with South Middlesex Registry of Deeds in Book 8387, page 236.

The aforementioned parcel of land shall not be conveyed by the commonwealth to said corporation unless said corporation first obtains a waiver of the applicable restrictions relative to the conveyance of said land imposed upon the commonwealth by the United States of America.

Chap. 592. AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF A CERTAIN BENEFIT WHICH MAY BE PAID BY THE WALTHAM POLICE RELIEF ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED TO CERTAIN MEMBERS PRIOR TO THEIR RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 314 of the acts of 1959 is hereby amended by striking out section 1, as amended by chapter 594 of the acts of 1961, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

Section 1. The Waltham Police Relief Association Incorporated, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized, upon the retirement of any member in good standing from the police department of the city of Waltham, to pay such member such sum, not exceeding two thousand five hundred dollars, as may be determined by vote of the board of directors of said corporation. Said association is hereby further authorized to pay to a member upon the death of his wife such sum, not exceeding five hundred dollars, as may be determined by said board.

Chap. 593. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BURLINGTON TO ABATE AND REFUND CERTAIN SEWER ASSESSMENTS FOR THE YEARS NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN TO NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE, INCLUSIVE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the town of Burlington is hereby authorized to abate any sewer assessments levied either by the Burlington Water and Sewer District, or by said town, during the years nineteen hundred and sixty-seven to nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, inclusive. Said town is hereby further authorized to appropriate and thereafter to refund to any persons who have paid such sewer assessments during any of said years any amounts so paid. Any funds appropriated for the purposes of this act shall be raised by taxation in said town.
