

the labor agreement between said town and the Westport Permanent Firefighters Association, Local 1802 International Association of Firefighters AFL-CIO retroactive to January first, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.

SECTION 2. Any action taken by the town of Westport at the special town meeting held on June tenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, shall be as valid and effective as though section one of this act had been in full force and effect at the time of the posting of the warrant for said meeting.

**Chap. 633.** AN ACT PROVIDING FOR INCREASED AMOUNTS OF ACCIDENTAL DEATH INSURANCE ON THE LIVES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND CERTAIN SUBDIVISIONS WHOSE DEATH, WHILE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES, OCCURS AS THE RESULT OF A ROBBERY OR ATTEMPTED ROBBERY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 10A of chapter 32A of the General Laws, inserted by section 5 of chapter 389 of the acts of 1960, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentence: — Notwithstanding the maximum dollar limits of the aforesaid amounts of group accidental death and dismemberment insurance and subject to such provisions of the group policy as may be provided by the commission, if a death occurs to an employee while in the performance of his duties and if such death occurs as the natural and proximate result of a robbery or attempted robbery, a further additional amount of accidental death insurance shall be payable in an amount equal to three times the sum of additional group life and group accidental death and dismemberment insurance applicable to said employee insured under this section.

**Chap. 634.** AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME DURING WHICH THE TOWN OF MIDDLEBOROUGH MAY LEVY ASSESSMENTS FOR THE COST OF CERTAIN BETTERMENTS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the failure of the town of Middleborough to comply with the provisions of sections one and two of chapter eighty and section forty-two I of chapter forty of the General Laws, said town may levy and collect assessments for betterments comprising water and sewer extension programs for the years nineteen hundred and sixty-six, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight and nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.

SECTION 2. The recording by the town of Middleborough of the orders, plans, estimates and assessments required under the provisions of sections one and two of chapter eighty and of section forty-two I of chapter forty of the General Laws is hereby validated and confirmed, notwithstanding the failure of said town to record the same within the time prescribed by said sections.
