

Chap. 668. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND GAME TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF CUMMINGTON FOR WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

For the purpose of establishing a public area for fishing, hunting and the management thereof, the division of fisheries and game of the department of natural resources is hereby authorized to acquire on behalf of the commonwealth, by eminent domain under the provisions of chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws, or by purchase or otherwise, a certain parcel of land in the town of Cummington, containing eighty acres, more or less, and described in a deed from Thomas S. Noska to The Council of Sportsmen's Clubs of Hampden County, Inc.; provided, however, that said land shall not include any lots on which any buildings are located on the effective date of this act.

Chap. 669. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF DRIVERS' LICENSES UNDER THE LAW RELATING TO CARRIERS OF PASSENGERS BY MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 9 of chapter 159A of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — No license shall be issued by the department except to persons at least twenty-one years of age who have qualified in accordance with the department's requirements.

Chap. 670. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF MENTAL HEALTH TO SELL CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF SHREWSBURY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The commissioner of mental health, acting for and on behalf of the commonwealth and subject to the approval of the governor, is hereby authorized to sell at public auction or to the highest responsible bidder after inviting sealed proposals, and thereafter to convey a parcel of land located on the Southerly side of Green street in the town of Shrewsbury, bounded and described as follows: — Beginning at a point on the southerly side of Green street at a drill hole located at the north-easterly corner of property owned by Raymond P. Galipeau et ux; thence running in an easterly direction along said Galipeau land 192.14 feet to a drill hole; thence turning and running in a southerly direction still along land of said Galipeau 379.12 feet to a drill hole; thence turning and running in a northwesterly direction, in a straight line 450 feet more or less to the point of beginning. Containing 36,000 square feet of land, more or less.

The conveyance is to be made subject to such conditions and restrictions as the commissioner shall deem advisable.
