**Chap. 712.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING LOUISE NELSON, A RETIRED EMPLOYEE OF THE TOWN OF STONEHAM, TO REJOIN THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF SAID TOWN AS AN ACTIVE MEMBER.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Notwithstanding any provision of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws to the contrary, Louise Nelson, a retired employee of the school department of the town of Stoneham, may, upon her reemployment by said town, again become an active member of the retirement system of said town; provided that she repays to the treasurer of said town the total amount of payments received by her as retirement allowances from the date of her retirement under said system to the date of her reemployment by said town.

*(This Bill, returned by the acting governor, to the Senate, the branch in which it originated, with his objections thereto, was passed by the Senate, May 19, 1969, and, in concurrence, by the House of Representatives, August 14, 1969, the objections of the acting governor notwithstanding, in the manner prescribed by the constitution; and thereby has "the force of a law".)*

**Chap. 713.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF TEWKSBURY TO EXTEND A CERTAIN SEWAGE SYSTEM TO THE BUILDING OF WANG LABORATORIES, INC. IN SAID TOWN.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 729 of the acts of 1968 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "not", in line 5, the words:—, except as provided in section one A.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 729 is hereby amended by inserting after section 1 the following section:—

Section 1A. The town of Tewksbury may extend the sewage system referred to in section one from the site of said new school in North Tewksbury to the building of Wang Laboratories, Inc. on North street in said town, provided that said Wang Laboratories, Inc. shall pay all expenses of installation and maintenance thereof.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 714.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF A REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT INCLUDING ALL THE GRADES FROM KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE TWELVE BY THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD AND THE TOWN OF RICHMOND.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The city of Pittsfield, by vote of its city council, and the town of Richmond, by vote in a town meeting, may create a special
