

Tyngsborough shall, upon the effective date of this act, continue until he reaches the age of sixty-five, but he may be removed therefrom for cause after hearing in the manner provided by section forty-three of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance to the voters of the town of Tyngsborough at the annual town meeting in the year nineteen hundred and seventy in the form of the following question, which shall be placed upon the official ballot to be used for the election of town officers at said meeting: — “Shall an act passed by the General Court in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, entitled ‘An Act providing tenure of office until age sixty-five for Howard F. Given, incumbent of the position of patrolman in the police department of the town of Tyngsborough’, be accepted?” If a majority of the votes in answer to said question is in the affirmative, this act shall thereupon take full effect, but not otherwise. *Approved August 19, 1969.*

Chap. 745. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF WATER POLLUTION CONTROL EXERCISE DUTIES OF THE DIRECTOR OF SAID DIVISION IN HIS ABSENCE OR DISABILITY, AND PROVIDING THAT CLEAN WATERS SCHOLARSHIP INTERNS SHALL BE EXEMPTED FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 26 of chapter 21 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 685 of the acts of 1966, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence: — In the event of the absence or the disability of the director, the assistant director shall perform the duties of the office.

SECTION 2. The third paragraph of section 38A of said chapter 21, as appearing in chapter 611 of the acts of 1968, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence: — Service rendered to the division by a recipient of such a scholarship during the three year period following his graduation, and during the regular periods of summer vacation, and such other vacation periods as the director may establish, shall not be subject to the provisions of chapter thirty-one.

Chap. 746. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD TO TAKE THE WATER RIGHTS TO ONOTA LAKE IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The city of Pittsfield is hereby authorized to take by eminent domain or to acquire by purchase or otherwise, for recreational and flood control purposes, the water rights and any land, buildings or other structures which may be necessarily incidental to the control of the flowage of the water in Onota lake located in said city. *Approved August 20, 1969.*
