

Chap. 763. AN ACT DIRECTING THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE THE TOWN OF TEMPLETON FOR CERTAIN MONIES EXPENDED FOR VETERANS' BENEFITS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

There shall be allowed and paid out of the state treasury to the town of Templeton, subject to appropriation and subject to the approval of the commissioner of veterans' services, such sum, not exceeding twenty-eight thousand two hundred and seventy-four dollars, as said town would have been entitled to receive in reimbursement for veterans' benefits paid by it in the years nineteen hundred and sixty-five, sixty-six, sixty-seven and sixty-eight under the provisions of section six of chapter one hundred and fifteen of the General Laws, had said town made a proper and seasonable report thereof to said commissioner as required by said section six.

Chap. 764. AN ACT DIRECTING THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE THE TOWN OF ROYALSTON FOR CERTAIN MONIES EXPENDED FOR VETERANS' BENEFITS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

There shall be allowed and paid out of the state treasury to the town of Royalston, subject to appropriation and subject to the approval of the commissioner of veterans' services, such sum, not exceeding nine hundred and ninety-one dollars, as said town would have been entitled to receive in reimbursement for veterans' benefits paid by it in the years nineteen hundred and sixty-five, sixty-seven and sixty-eight, under the provisions of section six of chapter one hundred and fifteen of the General Laws, had said town made a proper and seasonable report thereof to said commissioner as required by said section six.

Chap. 765. AN ACT DIRECTING THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE THE TOWN OF PHILLIPSTON FOR CERTAIN MONIES EXPENDED FOR VETERANS' BENEFITS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

There shall be allowed and paid out of the state treasury to the town of Phillipston, subject to appropriation and subject to the approval of the commissioner of veterans' services, such sum, not exceeding three thousand and thirty-five dollars, as said town would have been entitled to receive in reimbursement for veterans' benefits paid by it in the years nineteen hundred and sixty-five, sixty-six, sixty-seven and sixty-eight, under the provisions of section six of chapter one hundred and fifteen of the General Laws, had said town made a proper and seasonable report thereof to said commissioner as required by said section six.
