

two, and shall be due and payable on February first in said year in every city, town, and district in which the same are assessed.

Interest shall be paid at the rate of eight per cent on so much of the first billing as remains unpaid after November first, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, computed from October first of said year. Interest shall be paid at the rate of eight per cent on so much of the second billings as remains unpaid after May first, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, computed from April first of said year.

SECTION 79. Section one to seventy-five, inclusive, of this act shall take effect on July first, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

Chap. 850. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BOLTON TO ISSUE ONE RESTAURANT LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws to the contrary, the local licensing authority of the town of Bolton, as defined in section one of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, may grant one restaurant license under section twelve of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight to sell all alcoholic beverages during the years nineteen hundred and sixty-nine and nineteen hundred and seventy. Except as herein provided such license shall be subject to the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight.

SECTION 2. The state secretary shall cause to be placed on the official ballot to be used in the town of Bolton at each biennial state election the following additional subdivision to the question which he is required under the provisions of section eleven of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws to place on the official ballot in all cities and towns at such elections and the additional subdivision thereof which he is required under the provisions of chapter seven hundred and six of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-seven to place on the official ballot in the town of Bolton at such elections, to wit:

If a majority of votes cast in said town in answer to said subdivision F is in the affirmative, said town shall, irrespective of the results of votes in answer to subdivisions A, B, C, D and E, be taken to have authorized, for the two calendar years next succeeding, the issuance of a restaurant license as defined and limited in section twelve of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, for the sale in said town of all alcoholic beverages subject, except as herein otherwise provided, to all other provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
