

SECTION 3. The sum authorized in section two of this act shall be expended by the department to provide for payment of not more than one third of the total cost of right-of-way acquisition and reconstruction of said bridge. The remaining two thirds of said cost shall be borne jointly by the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority and the city of Quincy.

Chap. 865. AN ACT DIRECTING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY TO CONSTRUCT AND EQUIP A NEW COURT HOUSE FOR THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF EASTERN WORCESTER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Worcester county are hereby authorized and directed to construct and originally equip a court house to provide suitable and adequate facilities for the second district court of eastern Worcester. Said commissioners may take by eminent domain or acquire by purchase or otherwise any land that may be necessary for the purposes of this act, including a sufficient area for the parking of motor vehicles of persons in attendance upon said court. Said commissioners may expend for the purposes of this act, including the preparation of plans and specifications in connection therewith and for landscaping, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, one million dollars. Any sums received from the federal government for the purposes of this act shall be included in, and considered a part of, the total amount authorized to be expended hereunder.

SECTION 2. For the purposes authorized by section one, the treasurer of said county, with the approval of the county commissioners, may borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, one million dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the county therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, Second District Court of Eastern Worcester Court House Loan, Act of 1969. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and such loans shall be payable not more than twenty years from their dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county treasurer and countersigned by a majority of the county commissioners. The county may sell said securities at public or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as the county commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than their par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

SECTION 3. The metropolitan district commission, acting on behalf of the commonwealth, shall sell and convey to the county of Worcester for the purposes of section one a certain parcel of land situated on the easterly side of Boylston street (route 70) in the town of Clinton bounded and described as follows: — Beginning at a point located approximately 1000 feet Southerly of the entrance to the Wachusett Dam and approximately 80 feet Southerly of Bound #Sm 34, thence running 400 feet more or less along a line approximate bearing South 17° East, thence turning and running 650 feet more or less along a line approximate bearing North 73° East, thence turning and running 400 feet more or less along a line approximate bearing North 17° West, thence turning and running 650 feet more or less along a line approximate bearing South 73° West to the point of beginning.
