

**Chap. 163.** AN ACT FURTHER PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF RETAIL INSTALLMENT SALE AGREEMENTS UNDER THE LAW RELATIVE TO RETAIL INSTALLMENT SALES AND SERVICES.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Subsection B of section 9 of chapter 255D of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 284 of the acts of 1966, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "agreement", in line 1, the words: — shall be in writing and.

**Chap. 164.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BRISTOL COUNTY TO BORROW MONEY TO PROVIDE IMPROVED AND ADEQUATE ACCOMMODATIONS AND FACILITIES FOR THE FOURTH DISTRICT COURT OF BRISTOL.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing improved and adequate accommodations and facilities for the fourth district court of Bristol, the county commissioners of Bristol county are hereby authorized to construct an addition to the fourth district court of Bristol and to furnish and equip the same. Said commissioners may expend for the purpose of this act, including the preparation of plans and specifications in connection therewith, for counsel fees, landscaping and for a parking area, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, two hundred and fifty thousand dollars. Any sums received from the federal government for purposes of this act shall be included in, and considered a part of, the total amount authorized to be expended hereunder.

SECTION 2. For the purposes set forth in section one, the treasurer of Bristol county, with the approval of the county commissioners, may borrow from time to time on the credit of the county such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, two hundred and fifty thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the county therefor which shall bear on their face the words, Bristol County Court House Loan, Act of 1970. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be payable in not more than twenty years from their dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county treasurer and countersigned by a majority of the county commissioners. The county may sell said securities at public or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as the county commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than their par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

**Chap. 165.** AN ACT CLARIFYING THE APPLICATION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW REGARDING THE POSITIONS HELD BY PROFESSIONAL AND SUBPROFESSIONAL LIBRARIANS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 5 of chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out, in line 56, as appearing in section 8 of chapter 780 of the acts of 1967, the words "who hold" and inserting in place thereof the words: — whose duties require that they have.
