

Any violation of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of fifty dollars and each day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

**Chap. 202.** AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE HOLDER OF A RETAIL INSTALLMENT SALE AGREEMENT SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ALL DEFENSES WHICH THE INSTALLMENT BUYER MAY HAVE AGAINST THE INSTALLMENT SELLER.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chapter 255D of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 25 the following section: —

*Section 25A.* The holder of a retail installment sale agreement, or other person acting in his behalf, shall be subject to all defenses, real and personal, which the installment buyer may have against the installment seller thereof.

**Chap. 203.** AN ACT RELATIVE TO FURTHER STAY OF JUDGMENT AND EXECUTION IN ACTIONS OF SUMMARY PROCESS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 2 of chapter 365 of the acts of 1969 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2, the word "seventy" and inserting in place thereof the word: — seventy-two.

**Chap. 204.** AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE PROCESSING OF EMPLOYEE PAYROLLS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE ON A RETROACTIVE BASIS UNTIL JUNE 30, 1970.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Item 1900-1000 of section 2 of chapter 452 of the acts of 1969, as amended by section 2 of chapter 811 of said acts, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 8 and 9, the words "March first" and inserting in place thereof the following words: — June the thirtieth, — and by inserting after the word "list", in line 16, the words: — ; and provided, further, that notwithstanding any provision of the General Laws to the contrary, amounts encumbered on the records of the comptroller as 1969 Accounts Payable for personnel services under this item as of March the thirty-first, nineteen hundred and seventy are hereby extended to June the thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventy.
