Chap. 224. AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTIES FOR CERTAIN VIOLATIONS OF THE LAWS RELATIVE TO HUNTING AND FISHING.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 90 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 802 of the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 14, the words "five hundred" and inserting in place thereof the words: — one thousand.

SECTION 2. The seventh paragraph of said section 90 of said chapter 131, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — Whoever violates any provision of section sixty-five, sixty-six, sixty-seven or eighty-six shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty nor more than one thousand dollars, or by imprisonment for not more than one year, or both. *Approved April 22, 1970.*

Chap. 225. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF CERTAIN LICENSES TO SELL CERTAIN ARTICLES FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 33 of chapter 101 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 160 of the acts of 1945, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 1 and 2, the words "board of public welfare in any city or the selectmen in any town" and by inserting in place thereof the words: — selectmen in a town or in a city such board or officer as may be designated by ordinance. *Approved April 22, 1970.*

Chap. 226. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ESSEX COUNTY TO BORROW MONEY TO ALTER, REPAIR, RENOVATE AND EQUIP THE COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT HOUSE IN THE CITY OF LAWRENCE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Essex county are hereby authorized to raise and expend a sum not exceeding three hundred thousand dollars, for such repairs, alterations, renovations and equipping of the county superior court house in the city of Lawrence, as they deem necessary and proper, including plans and specifications and architect's fees and expenses connected therewith. Any sums received from the federal government for the purposes of this act shall be included in, and considered a part of, the total amount to be expended hereunder.

SECTION 2. For the purposes aforesaid, the treasurer of said county, with the approval of the county commissioners, may borrow upon the
