

Chap. 325. AN ACT AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY REGISTRATION AS QUALIFIED PHYSICIANS UNDER DESIGNATED CIRCUMSTANCES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 9A the following section:—

Section 9B. Temporary registration as a qualified physician may be granted (1) to a visiting physician holding a license to practice in another state or territory or in the District of Columbia or in another country and having a temporary faculty appointment certified by the dean of a medical school in the commonwealth for purposes of medical education in an accredited hospital associated with the medical school, such registration to terminate automatically upon termination of the faculty appointment and, in any event, at the end of eight months; (2) to a physician holding a license to practice in another state or territory or in the District of Columbia to permit him to act as a substitute physician for a registered physician in the commonwealth, to be granted only upon written request of said registered physician and to be limited to three months or less; (3) to a physician eligible for examination or registration in the commonwealth who is a diplomate of a specialty board approved by the American Medical Association or the American Osteopathic Association to permit him to act as a substitute physician for a registered physician in the commonwealth to be granted only upon written request of said registered physician, to be limited to the specialty in which the applicant is certified and to be limited to three months or less.

Chap. 326. AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING INDUSTRIAL ENTERPRISES AND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT FACILITIES AS USED IN THE LAW RELATIVE TO INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT OF CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 40D of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (k) and (l), as appearing in section 1 of chapter 772 of the acts of 1967, and inserting in place thereof the following two paragraphs:—

(k) "Industrial enterprise", an enterprise engaged in applying skill and labor to the giving of new shapes, new qualities or new combinations to matter as material products or to the preservation, storage, handling or transportation of manufactured or natural products.

(l) "Industrial development facilities" or "facilities", used in connection with any industrial, manufacturing, or research and development enterprise, or any part thereof, located within or partially within the municipality creating an authority, and acquired or constructed by municipalities acting by and through said authority or an industrial occupant pursuant to the terms of this chapter, including any or all buildings, docks, wharves, improvements, additions, extensions, replacements, appurtenances, lands, rights in land, riparian rights,
