

Chap. 380. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MILLVILLE TO USE CERTAIN PARK LAND IN SAID TOWN FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FIRE STATION.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Millville is hereby authorized to use, for the purpose of constructing thereon a fire station, certain park land in said town, bounded and described as follows: —

Beginning at the most westerly corner thereof at a point in the northeasterly line of Main Street, which point is one hundred twenty (120) feet southeasterly of the intersection of the southeasterly line of Lincoln Street with the northeasterly line of Main Street, and which point is also the most southerly corner of land formerly of the Fall River Gas Station and now of Leo Hartshorn et ux;

Thence northeasterly by land of said Hartshorn et ux and by land now or formerly of Daniel McNeil a total distance of one hundred eighty (180) feet more or less to land now or formerly of Robert Bowen;

Thence southeasterly by said Bowen land, now or formerly, ninety five (95) feet more or less to a point;

Thence southwesterly by other park land one hundred sixteen (116) feet more or less to a point in the northeasterly line of Main Street which is one hundred (100) feet southeasterly of (measured on said northeasterly line of Main Street) the point or place of beginning;

Thence northwesterly by the northeasterly line of Main Street one hundred (100) feet to the point or place of beginning.

Said premises being shown on a plan of land entitled "Plan of Land Millville, Mass. for Location of Proposed Millville Fire Station Jan. 1970. Scale 1 in. = 30 ft. Stanley H. Mowry — Surveyor."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 381. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE RESIGNATION OF MUNICIPAL OFFICERS SHALL NOT BECOME EFFECTIVE UNTIL FILED WITH THE CLERK OF THE MUNICIPALITY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 109 of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 54 of the acts of 1964, is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — No resignation of a town or district officer shall be deemed effective unless and until such resignation is filed with the town or district clerk or such later time certain as may be specified in such resignation.

Chap. 382. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE PROVIDING OF INSURANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPENSATING CALL AND VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS AND RESERVE, SPECIAL AND INTERMITTENT POLICE OFFICERS WHO HAVE BEEN DISABLED IN CERTAIN CASES AND AUTHORIZING THE INDEMNITY OF VOLUNTEER FIREMEN FOR LOSS OF COMPENSATION IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 85H of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the word "fighter", in line 13, as appearing
