Chap. 411. AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME DURING WHICH CERTAIN PERSONS SERVING IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES MAY APPLY FOR REGISTRATION AS A LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT WITHOUT EXAMINATION.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately permit the registration of certain members of the armed forces as landscape architects, without examination, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 3 of chapter 473 of the acts of 1968 is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:—In the case of a person serving in the armed forces of the United States on the effective date of this act, such one year period shall not commence until his separation or discharge from such service.

Chap. 412. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE BORROWING POWER OF THE LOWELL TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTE BUILDING AUTHORITY, THE SOUTHEASTERN MASSACHUSETTS UNIVERSITY BUILDING AUTHORITY, THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE COLLEGE BUILDING AUTHORITY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS BUILDING AUTHORITY.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is, in part, to provide forthwith urgently needed facilities for students at Southeastern Massachusetts University, Lowell Technological Institute, the state colleges and the University of Massachusetts, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The fourth sentence of the fifth paragraph of section 7 of chapter 557 of the acts of 1961 is hereby amended by striking out the
