

Chap. 661. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BEVERLY TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF AND TO PAY A CERTAIN UNPAID BILL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The city of Beverly is hereby authorized to appropriate the sum of seven thousand one hundred and twenty-three dollars for payment of, and after such appropriation the treasurer of said city is hereby authorized to pay, an unpaid bill in said amount to Vitale and Sons Co., Inc. for snow removal.

SECTION 2. No bill shall be approved by the city auditor of said city for payment or paid by the treasurer thereof under authority of this act unless and until a certificate has been signed and filed with said city auditor, stating under the penalties of perjury that the goods, materials or services for which the bill has been submitted were ordered by an official or an employee of said city and that such goods and materials were delivered and actually received by said city or that such services were rendered to said city, or both.

Chap. 662. AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF MUNICIPAL GAS AND ELECTRIC PLANTS IN GROUP 4 OF THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. *Group 2* of paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 11 to 14, inclusive, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 650 of the acts of 1968, the words “, employees of a municipal gas or electric plant who are employed as linemen, electric switchboard operators, electric maintenance men, steam engineers, boiler operators, firemen, oilers, mechanical maintenance men and supervisors of said employees”.

SECTION 2. *Group 4* of said paragraph (g) of said subdivision (2) of said section 3 of said chapter 32 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 8, as appearing in section 2 of said chapter 650, the word “and” and inserting in place thereof the words:—, employees of a municipal gas or electric plant who are employed as linemen, electric switchboard operators, electric maintenance men, steam engineers, boiler operators, firemen, oilers, mechanical maintenance men and supervisors of said employees, and.

Chap. 663. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PLYMOUTH COUNTY TO ACQUIRE LAND IN THE TOWN OF ROCHESTER FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW COURTHOUSE FOR THE FOURTH DISTRICT COURT OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Plymouth county are hereby authorized and directed to take by eminent domain, or acquire by gift, purchase or otherwise, land in the town of Rochester, for the con-
