Chap. 733. AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR THE ISSUANCE TO RESIDENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH WHILE IN THE ACTIVE MILITARY OR NAVAL SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES OF SPECIAL CERTIFICATES WITHOUT FEE ENTITLING THEM TO HUNT AND FISH.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 554 of the acts of 1968 is hereby amended by striking out section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following section: —

Section 2. This act shall cease to be effective on January the first, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.

Chap. 734. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION OF GOODS BY MOTOR VEHICLE AND THE PERFORMANCE OF WORK IN CERTAIN OFFICES ON CERTAIN LEGAL HOLIDAYS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 14 of chapter 136 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence, inserted by chapter 213 of the acts of 1969, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — The transport of goods in commerce, or for a consideration, by motor truck or trailer, between the hours of eight o'clock in the morning and eight o'clock in the evening, shall not be prohibited on any legal holiday to which the provisions of sections five to eleven, inclusive, apply, provided such goods are destined for or emanate from an establishment in the commonwealth for which a permit has been issued under the provisions of section fifteen, or is otherwise lawfully operating on the holiday.

SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 15 of said chapter 136 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "holiday", in line 8, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 616 of the acts of 1962, the following sentence: — In addition, such persons or boards may grant a permit for the performance of work on such holiday by clerical and office personnel in offices which are corporate offices or branches of interstate manufacturing operations working in other states on such holiday or in offices connected with manufacturing plants in the commonwealth whether or not production work is being carried on therein on such holiday, if inconvenience will result if such work is not performed on such holiday.

Chap. 735. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO DEVELOP A NATURAL RESOURCE CONSERVATION INSTRUCTIONAL CENTER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 607 of the acts of 1968 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "areas", in line 7, the words: — and a natural resource conservation instructional center.
