

SECTION 2. For the purposes authorized by section one, the treasurer of said county, with the approval of the county commissioners, may borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, three hundred and sixty thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the county therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, Hampden County Court House Planning and Land Acquisition Loan, District Court of Holyoke, Act of 1970. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and such loans shall be payable in not more than twenty years from their dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county treasurer and countersigned by a majority of the county commissioners. The county may sell said securities at public or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as the county commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than their par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 808. AN ACT EXTENDING THE EXPIRATION DATE OF A CERTAIN CIVIL SERVICE LIST.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith that there be at all times an established list of qualified candidates for the position of junior right-of-way agent in the department of public works, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding any provision of the General Laws, governing the expiration date of civil service lists, the list for the position of junior right-of-way agent in the department of public works, established on August the nineteenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, shall be revived and extended for a period not to exceed one hundred and twenty days from the effective date of this act. *Approved August 27, 1970.*

Chap. 809. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE BEING PAID TO JOSEPH SAVIANO BY THE TOWN OF NATICK SHALL BE RETROACTIVE TO THE DATE OF THE TERMINATION OF HIS EMPLOYMENT BY SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The accidental disability retirement allowance being paid to Joseph Saviano by the town of Natick under the provisions of chapter four hundred and nineteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-eight shall be retroactive to October the eighteenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, the date of the termination of his service as a paid employee of the public works department of said town.
