

county, for displays or booths and the staffing thereof maintained at fairs, expositions or travel shows outside the county, for such other promotional activities as may be reasonably necessary to effectuate the purposes of this act and the processing of inquiries resulting from such promotional activities. In carrying out the provisions of this act the commissioners may designate an agent or agents to act for them; provided, that all bills incurred shall be accompanied by proper vouchers and shall be paid by the county treasurer only on warrants approved by the county commissioners or a majority of them.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance during the current year by the county commissioners of Essex county, but not otherwise.

**Chap. 86.** AN ACT POSTPONING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE IMPOSITION OF FINANCE CHARGES IN CERTAIN REVOLVING CREDIT AGREEMENTS.

*Whereas,* The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to postpone forthwith the effective date of chapter eight hundred and twenty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 822 of the acts of 1970 is hereby amended by striking out the word "April" and inserting in place thereof the word: — June, — so as to read as follows: —

*Section 6.* This act shall take effect on June the first, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 87.** AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING DOG RACING MEETINGS.

*Whereas,* The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose which is in part to extend immediately the time within which dog racing meetings may be held, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 128A of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out clause (e), as most recently amended by chapter 116 of the acts of 1958, and inserting in place thereof the following clause: —

(e) Such dog racing meetings may be held only between the first day of April and the thirtieth day of November, both dates inclusive, in any year.

SECTION 2. Said section 3 of said chapter 128A is hereby further amended by striking out clause (g), as appearing in section 3 of chapter 374 of the acts of 1934, and inserting in place thereof the following clause: —
