

affiliations concurrent with his duties as the commissioner may approve, including the holding of a nontenure appointment at a university. Said assistant commissioner shall, with the approval of the commissioner, establish and maintain standards for all clinical and child care positions in the department and shall review the qualifications and performances of all clinical and child care personnel. The commissioner shall appoint replacement or additional clinical and child care personnel upon recommendation of said assistant commissioner together with the assistant commissioner of any other bureau requesting such personnel.

**Chap. 174.** AN ACT EXTENDING THE PERIOD OF TIME FOR REQUESTING HEARINGS ON SUSPENSIONS OR REVOCATIONS OF MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSES OR REGISTRATIONS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Clause (b) of section 22 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 637 of the acts of 1969, is hereby amended by striking out the third sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — Said notice shall specify the reasons for the intended suspension or revocation and shall inform the operator of his right to request in writing a hearing within fourteen days after the date of such notice on the question of whether there is just cause for such suspension or revocation.

**Chap. 175.** AN ACT REQUIRING MOTORCYCLES TO BE EQUIPPED WITH LOCKS OR KEYS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 7 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the eleventh sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — Every motor vehicle so operated shall be provided with a muffler or other suitable device to prevent unnecessary noise and with a suitable bell, horn or other means of signalling, with suitable lamps, and with a lock, key or other device to prevent such vehicle from being set in motion by unauthorized persons, or otherwise contrary to the will of the owner or person in charge thereof.

**Chap. 176.** AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF COUNTERFEIT OR STOLEN LEARNERS' PERMITS AND MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTION STICKERS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 24B of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph, as most recently amended by chapter 224 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

Whoever falsely makes, steals, alters, forges or counterfeits or procures or assists another to falsely make, steal, alter, forge or counterfeit
