

At the end of each fiscal year, the commissioner shall make an annual report of the activities of the department, and of each district, facility, clinic, or unit under its control, the cost of operating the same, the initiation of new programs, the progress made in providing services and facilities for mental health and mental retardation in the commonwealth and the number of escapes, if any, from any of such facilities and the circumstances thereof.

Chap. 194. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REVOCATION OF CERTAIN PRIVILEGES EXTENDED TO OWNERS OR OPERATORS OF MOTOR VEHICLES, PAYMENT FOR WHICH HAS BEEN MADE BY CHECK WHICH IS NOT DULY PAID.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The last paragraph of section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, added by section 3 of chapter 742 of the acts of 1969, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence: — If the payment of any such fee is made by check and said check is not duly paid, the registrar may, after hearing, revoke and order the return of any learner's permit, license to operate motor vehicles, certificate of registration, number plate, sticker, decal or other thing for which the check was tendered.

Chap. 195. AN ACT CLARIFYING THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW RELATIVE TO TEMPORARY TRANSFERS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 15G of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as amended by section 10 of chapter 652 of the acts of 1968, is hereby further amended by striking out the fifth sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — No provisional appointment or provisional promotion shall be approved or continued following a certification by the director if the list contains the names of three persons eligible and willing to accept.

Chap. 196. AN ACT PROVIDING AN OPPORTUNITY FOR INTERESTED EMPLOYEES TO MEET WITH THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ELECTED OR APPOINTED UNDER THE LAW RELATIVE TO GROUP INSURANCE FOR EMPLOYEES OF COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS AND DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 3 of chapter 32B of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 334 of the acts of 1961, the following sentence: — Said advisory committee shall establish a procedure to provide a reasonable opportunity for all interested employees to meet with it so that the recommendations of the committee will be a fair representation of all employees' interests.
