Chap. 259. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE ORGANIZATION OF PROFESSIONAL CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 8 of chapter 156A of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 654 of the acts of 1963, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—No person may be simultaneously an officer, director or shareholder of more than two professional corporations.

Chap. 260. AN ACT REQUIRING LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITIES TO DISCLOSE THEIR REASONS FOR ANY ACTION TAKEN RELATIVE TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 23 of chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as appearing in section 12 of chapter 542 of the acts of 1943, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—The terms licenses and permits, wherever employed as substantives in this chapter, are used in their technical sense of a license or permit, transferable only as provided in this chapter, and revocable by the granting authority, the commonwealth, acting through the same officers or agents and under the same delegated authority for any violation of this chapter or any
