

such certified copy of a decree of adoption, shall forthwith correct the record of birth of the person so adopted in the manner hereinafter provided and notify the adopting parents or parent that the requested amendment of the record has been made and that upon receipt of the fee prescribed by section thirty-four of chapter two hundred and sixty-two he shall furnish a certified copy of such record, as so amended.

**Chap. 267.** AN ACT INCREASING THE ENTRY FEE OF A LIBEL FOR DIVORCE OR FOR AFFIRMING OR ANNULING MARRIAGE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 40 of chapter 262 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 651 of the acts of 1967, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

For the entry of a libel for divorce or for affirming or annulling marriage, twenty-five dollars.

**Chap. 268.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NORTH ATTLEBOROUGH TO PAY CERTAIN UNPAID BILLS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Notwithstanding any by-law of the town of North Attleborough or any general or special law to the contrary, said town is hereby authorized to pay on certification by the high school building committee appointed under article seventeen of the warrant of the special town meeting held on July twenty-four, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight certain unpaid bills in the amount of seven hundred and twelve dollars and thirty cents.

**Chap. 269.** AN ACT INCREASING THE FEE FOR A CERTIFICATE OF MUNICIPAL LIENS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 23 of chapter 60 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the fourth sentence, as appearing in chapter 537 of the acts of 1958, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— Such collector of taxes shall charge six dollars for each certificate so issued, and the money so received shall be paid into the town treasury.

**Chap. 270.** AN ACT INCREASING THE RATE OF INTEREST ON UNPAID BETTERMENT ASSESSMENTS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 13 of chapter 80 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as amended by chapter 595 of the acts of 1941, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— Assessments made under this chapter shall bear interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum from the thirtieth day after the assessments have been committed to the collector.
