

Chap. 438. AN ACT INCREASING THE CHARGE FOR TOWING FEES DURING SNOW EMERGENCIES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The fourth sentence of section 22D of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 369 of the acts of 1968, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 4, the word "twelve" and inserting in place thereof the word:—twenty-five. *Approved June 25, 1971.*

Chap. 439. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE RIGHT OF TRANSFER DURING A PROBATIONARY PERIOD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 16A of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 637 of the acts of 1968, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "rules", in line 2, the words:—and who has served a probationary period required by section twenty D.

SECTION 2. Said section 16A is hereby further amended by striking out the second paragraph, as so appearing, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

If such transfer shall be to a temporary position, the transfer shall be temporary and for such period of time as the appointing authority shall determine, with the consent of the director and, if the position is in the service of the commonwealth, of the director of personnel and standardization. If such transfer shall be to a permanent position, the transfer shall be permanent or temporary, as the appointing authority shall determine, with the consent of the director; and if temporary, shall be for such period of time as the appointing authority shall determine, with the consent of the director. A temporary transfer shall not affect the seniority date of the employee so transferred and shall not be deemed to interrupt the serving of the period of eligibility for promotion required by this chapter in the office or position from which the employee is transferred.

SECTION 3. Said section 16A of said chapter 31 is hereby further amended by striking out the third paragraph, as so appearing.

Chap. 440. AN ACT MAKING A CORRECTIVE CHANGE IN THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD OF STATE EXAMINERS OF ELECTRICIANS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 32 of chapter 13 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently amended by chapter 238 of the acts of 1954, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—The state examiners of electricians, hereinafter called the board, shall consist of the director of civil service, the state fire marshal and the associate commissioner for the division of occupational education in the department of education, ex officio, and two persons to be appointed for terms of three years each by the governor.
