DECISION

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether VDB Corporation d.b.a. ODB Liquors violated *204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch.138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 Count)*.

The licensee stipulated to the facts contained in the Investigator's report dated March 24, 2009.

The compliance check field report states an underage operative working with A.B.C.C. Investigators purchased a 40 oz Bottle of Budweiser ODB Liquors. The young man, d.o.b. 9/21/1988 (age 20), was not asked for identification by the store clerk prior to service.

The Commission finds the licensee violated *204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch.138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 Count)* and, therefore **suspends the license for 3 days of which 3 days will be held in abeyance for a period of two years provided no further violations of Ch. 138 or Commission regulations occur.**
