

section a sum not exceeding three hundred dollars; provided, that the total expense of the funeral and burial does not exceed five hundred dollars; and provided, further, that any payment made by said commission shall be reduced by whatever resources may exist in the estate of such deceased blind person. Payment under this section may be made directly to the person furnishing such service.

**Chap. 776.** AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO INSTALL TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF PINE STREET, BRIDGE STREET AND AMES STREET IN THE TOWN OF DEDHAM.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The department of public works is hereby authorized and directed to install traffic control signals at the intersection of Pine, Bridge and Ames streets in the town of Dedham. For said purpose said department may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

**Chap. 777.** AN ACT INCREASING THE FILING FEE FOR CERTAIN DOCUMENTS IN REGISTRIES OF DEEDS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 9-403 of chapter 106 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out subsection (5), as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 131 of the acts of 1961, and inserting in place thereof the following subsection: —

(5) The fee for filing, indexing and furnishing filing data for an original or a continuation statement or any amendment of either shall be three dollars, except in registries of deeds where it shall be five dollars, but if an original financing statement or any amendment thereof which is filed in a registry of deeds consists of more than one page, the fee for filing and indexing the same and furnishing filing data with respect thereto shall be as set forth in sections thirty-eight and thirty-nine of chapter two hundred and sixty-two. *Approved September 16, 1971.*

**Chap. 778.** AN ACT RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CITY TREASURER OF THE CITY OF BROCKTON.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws and the vote under section forty-nine A thereof passed at the regular municipal election held in the city of Brockton on the fourth day of November in nineteen hundred and forty-seven, the city treasurer of said city shall be appointed in accordance with the charter of said city and such other laws as may be applicable.

SECTION 2. Nothing contained in this act shall prevent the placing of the office of city treasurer within the classified civil service pursuant to the provisions of said chapter thirty-one.

SECTION 3. This act shall be submitted for acceptance to the voters of the city of Brockton at the municipal election to be held in the year nineteen hundred and seventy-one in the form of the following question,
