After a hearing on October 25, 2011, the Commission finds Parul B. Corporation dba Crossroads Variety in violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34.

The Commission **suspends the licensee's license for a total of two (2) days to be served.** The suspension shall commence on **Wednesday, December 28, 2011 and terminate on Thursday, December 29, 2011.** The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Wednesday, December 28, 2011 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Friday, December 30, 2011.

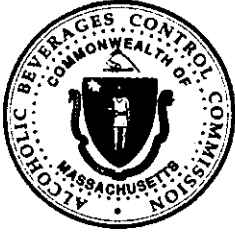
You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 §23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form. All checks must be certified and accompanied by the enclosed form, which must be signed by a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

Parul B. Corporation dba Crossroads Variety (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 25, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jan Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jan Kujawski.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On, August 29, 2011 at approximately 6:26 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Parul B. Corporation dba Crossroads Variety.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a forty (40) ounce of Bud for three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. Administrative review of the file indicates the licensee had a prior violation in 1998.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which two (2) days will be served and one (1) day will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
