

Way; thence running northerly about one hundred forty-three (143) feet by land now or formerly of Emmerton; thence northerly by land of the Salem Hospital about one thousand and twenty (1,020) feet; thence easterly by Bertram Field about three hundred forty-eight (348) feet; thence northerly by Bertram Field about seventy-eight (78) feet; thence easterly by Bertram Field about twenty (20) feet; thence southerly by other land of the City of Salem about nine hundred fifty (950) feet; thence southwesterly by land now or formerly of Dora Eaton about four hundred fifty (450) feet; thence northerly by the side line of Ancient Way about forty-eight (48) feet; thence westerly across the end of Ancient Way about forty (40) feet to the point of beginning, and containing about nine and one tenth (9.1) acres as shown on "Plan of Land in Salem, Mass." by Whitman & Howard, Inc., Engineers, dated April, 1966.

SECTION 2. Chapter seven hundred and fourteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-six is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by the city of Salem.

**Chap. 849.** AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICIES TO CERTAIN ORGANIZATIONS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 111E of chapter 175 of the General Laws, inserted by chapter 760 of the acts of 1963, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 7 and 8, the words "twenty-five thousand" and inserting in place thereof the words:—five hundred.

**Chap. 850.** AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR EXEMPTION UNDER THE LAW IMPOSING A TAX ON RETAIL SALES OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Paragraph (k) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 757 of the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:— For the purposes of this section clothing or footwear shall not include special clothing or footwear primarily designed for athletic activity or protective use and which is not normally worn except when so used.

**Chap. 851.** AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A THIRD ASSISTANT REGISTER OF PROBATE FOR PLYMOUTH COUNTY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chapter 217 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 24A the following section:—

*Section 24B.* The judges of probate for the county of Plymouth may appoint a third assistant register of probate for said county, who shall hold office for three years unless sooner removed by the judges. He shall be subject to the laws relative to assistant registers.
