

Chap. 852. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SIXTH ASSISTANT REGISTER FOR THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY PROBATE COURT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 217 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 25, as most recently amended by chapter 511 of the acts of 1957, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —

Section 25. The majority of the judges of probate for Middlesex county may appoint a third, fourth, fifth and sixth assistant register for said county, who shall hold office for three years unless sooner removed by the judges. They shall be subject to the laws relative to assistant registers, except that the bond shall be approved by a majority of the judges.

SECTION 2. Section 35B of said chapter 217 is hereby amended by striking out the last paragraph, as appearing in section 3 of chapter 736 of the acts of 1960, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

The salary of a fifth or sixth assistant register of probate shall be fifty-five per cent of the salary of the register in his county.

Chap. 853. AN ACT DIRECTING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A CERTAIN ENTRANCE AT FIELDS CORNER STATION.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority is hereby authorized and directed to construct and maintain an entrance and egress from the upper level of its Fields Corner station to Charles street in the Dorchester district of the city of Boston.

Chap. 854. AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH TO GRANT AN EASEMENT TO THE TOWN OF SHREWSBURY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The department of mental health, in the name and on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized and directed to grant to the town of Shrewsbury, a permanent easement for municipal light department purposes over a parcel of land owned by the commonwealth, being more particularly described as follows: —

BEGINNING at a point, said point being the northwest lot corner of land owned by the Town of Shrewsbury;

THENCE N 72°W, 580 feet more or less along a stonewall to a point on the easterly sideline of Lake Street;

THENCE southerly 25 feet more or less along said sideline to a point;

THENCE S 72°E, 580 feet more or less through land owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to a point on the westerly lot line of land owned by the Town of Shrewsbury;

THENCE N 9° 41'E, 25 feet more or less along said lot line to the point of beginning.

The above described parcel contains 14,500 square feet more or less.
