Chap. 351. AN ACT VALIDATING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE PERSONNEL BY-LAW IN THE TOWN OF ABINGTON.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The action taken at the annual town meeting of the town of Abington in the year nineteen hundred and seventy-one in amending the personnel by-law by adding sections twenty and twenty-one, relative to severance pay of fire department employees and including members of the police department in the educational incentive program, are hereby confirmed and validated. Any monies which are necessary for the implementation of the aforesaid sections may be appropriated and expended by said town. Any appropriations or expenditures already made relative to the addition of sections twenty and twenty-one to the personnel by-law are hereby validated and confirmed as though this act were in effect at the time of the posting of the warrant for said meeting.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 352. AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTIFICATES OF LIMITED REGISTRATION WHICH MAY BE ISSUED TO CERTAIN PHYSICIANS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 234 of the acts of 1968 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "registration", in line 7, the words:—as set forth in section nine of chapter one hundred twelve of the General Laws.

Chap. 353. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR NOTICE BY AN EMPLOYER TO AN EMPLOYEE WHOSE EMPLOYMENT IS BEING TERMINATED OF HIS GROUP INSURANCE TERMINATION DATE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting the following section:—

Section 178 O. An employer terminating employment of an employee insured under a group insurance policy shall, within ten business days, notify said employee of the date upon which his coverage under his group insurance policy shall terminate.
