

Chap. 535. AN ACT CLARIFYING THE AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HAMPDEN COUNTY TO CONSTRUCT AND EQUIP A BUILDING FOR THE COURTS AND VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF THE COUNTY AND TO BORROW MONEY THEREFOR.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Any limit contained in chapter eight hundred and fifty-one of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine notwithstanding, the county commissioners of Hampden county are hereby authorized to cause plans and specifications to be prepared for the construction project authorized by chapter one thousand one hundred and twelve of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-one, and to acquire land for said project within the area authorized by said chapter one thousand one hundred and twelve, the total cost of such project including the cost of such plans and specifications and the cost of land acquisition to be not more than the total amount of borrowings authorized by said chapters eight hundred and fifty-one and one thousand one hundred and twelve.

SECTION 2. Any amounts authorized to be borrowed by said chapter eight hundred and fifty-one not required for the preparation of plans and specifications and the acquisition of land and any amounts authorized to be borrowed by said chapter one thousand one hundred and twelve not required for the construction project authorized by said chapter one thousand one hundred and twelve may be used for the demolition and renovation, re-equipping and refurbishing projects authorized by said chapter one thousand one hundred and twelve.

SECTION 3. Nothing in this act shall increase the aggregate amount which may be borrowed by the county commissioners for the projects described in said chapters eight hundred and fifty-one and one thousand one hundred and twelve beyond the aggregate amounts authorized by those acts.

Chap. 536. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE SWIMMING POOL TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN THE CITY OF BROCKTON AS THE FRANK A. MANNING SWIMMING POOL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The swimming pool to be constructed in the city of Brockton by the department of natural resources shall, upon completion, be known and designated as the Frank A. Manning swimming pool, in memory of Frank A. Manning, a former member of the house of representatives and a former mayor of the city of Brockton. A suitable marker bearing such designation shall be erected and maintained at said swimming pool by the department of natural resources.
