Secretary O'Connell Announces Receipt Of Analysis On Expanded Gaming In Commonwealth

Comprehensive Independent Report Addresses Economic Impacts, Employment, Social Costs

BOSTON- Thursday, August 7, 2008 - The Commonwealth's Executive Office of Housing and Economic Development today announced its receipt of an expanded gaming analysis prepared by Spectrum Gaming Group.

Secretary of Housing and Economic Development Daniel O'Connell was directed to obtain an independent and comprehensive analysis of the potential impact of expanded gaming in the Commonwealth, following Governor Deval Patrick's proposal last September to authorize up to three destination resort casinos in Massachusetts
