The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

AN ACT GIVING TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION CERTAIN POWERS OF POLICE OFFICERS WITHIN STATE FORESTS AND STATE PARKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section ten of chapter one hundred and twenty-
2 nine A of the General Laws, as appearing in section
3 one of chapter three hundred and twenty-nine of the
4 acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-three, is hereby
5 amended by inserting at the end the following sen-
6 tence:—

7 Forest supervisors, park superintendents and la-
8 borers employed by the department, while employed
9 in state forests, state parks or reservations shall,
10 within the limits of said forests, parks or reservations
11 have and exercise all the powers of constables, except
12 service of civil process, and of police officers if so
13 authorized in writing by the commissioner.
