Accompanying the second recommendation of the State Examiners of Electricians (House, No. 66). The Judiciary.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE EXAMINERS OF ELECTRICIANS TO SUMMON WITNESSES, ADMINISTER OATHS AND TAKE TESTIMONY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter one hundred and forty-one of the Gen-
2 eral Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
3 section four the following new section:—

4 *Section 4A.* In all hearings conducted by the
5 examiners under authority of section four, any ex-
6 aminer may summon witnesses, may administer
7 oaths, take testimony, and require the production
8 of books and papers by a subpoena duces tecum.
9 Fees and mileage shall be the same as for witnesses
10 before the courts in civil actions, and shall be paid
11 in the same manner as the expenses of the examiners
12 are paid. Any justice of the superior court may,
13 on petition of the examiners, enforce by proper pro-
14 ceedings the provisions of this section.
