RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SPECIAL COMMISSION TO INVESTIGATE AND STUDY AND TO RECOMMEND ANY NECESSARY CHANGES IN THE INSURANCE LAWS PERTAINING TO THE INVESTMENTS OF THE CAPITAL AND RESERVES OF INSURANCE COMPANIES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special unpaid commission to con-
2 sist of two members of the Senate to be designated by
3 the president thereof, two members of the House of
4 Representatives to be designated by the speaker
5 thereof, and the Commissioner of Insurance or a
6 member of the Insurance Department staff to be desig-
7 nated by the Commissioner, is hereby established for
8 the purpose of making an investigation and study to
9 determine whether or not any changes or amend-
10 ments in the present insurance laws relating to the
11 investment of the capital and reserves of insurance
12 companies should be recommended.

13 Said commission shall hold public hearings and
14 shall report to the General Court the results of its
15 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if
16 any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to
17 carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the
18 same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
19 on or before the first day of April, one thousand nine
20 hundred and forty-one.
