RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY OF PROVIDING THAT THE SALARIES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE AND OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES SHALL BE ESTABLISHED AND PAID BY THE RESPECTIVE SENATORIAL AND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICTS OF THE SENATORS AND REPRESENTATIVES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special unpaid commission, to  
2 consist of one member of the senate to be designated  
3 by the president thereof, three members of the house  
4 of representatives to be designated by the speaker  
5 thereof and three persons to be appointed by the  
6 governor, with the advice and consent of the council,  
7 is hereby established for the purpose of making an  
8 investigation of the advisability of providing that the  
9 salaries of the members of the senate and of the house  
10 of representatives be established and paid by the  
11 respective senatorial and representative districts of  
12 said senators and representatives. Said commission  
13 shall report to the general court the results of its

14 investigation and its recommendations, if any, together  
15 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said  
16 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with  
17 the clerk of the house of representatives at the next  
18 regular or special session of the general court.
