AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MINIMUM LEGAL SALARY OF PUBLIC DAY SCHOOL TEACHERS TO NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS A YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section forty of chapter seventy-one of the General
2 Laws, Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the words "seven hundred and fifty"
4 and inserting in place thereof the words: — nine hun-
5 dred and fifty, — so that said section shall read as
6 follows: — The compensation of every teacher em-
7 ployed in any public day school in the common-
8 wealth, except persons in training and those em-
9 ployed as temporary substitutes, shall be at a rate
10 of not less than nine hundred and fifty dollars for
11 the school year in that school.
