## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

---

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

---

AN ACT TO REGULATE A STANDARD RATE OR BASE, BY WHICH ALL CITIES AND TOWNS WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH WILL PAY THEIR ELECTRIC LIGHT BILLS TO PRIVATELY OWNED ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER CORPORATIONS OR TRUSTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The charges for electric lights to any city or town  
2 within the commonwealth shall be based or rated  
3 on the amount of current consumed by each electric  
4 light or by the amount of current consumed by all  
5 the electric lights combined. The unit that shall be  
6 used shall in all cases be so much per kilowatt hour,  
7 that is, the unit is a kilowatt hour.

8 This unit is mandatory upon all privately owned  
9 electric light and power corporations or trusts.
