By Mr. Iris of Brockton, petition of the Massachusetts Cosmetology School Owners Association relative to qualifications of applicants for registration as operators under the law regulating the occupation of hairdressing. Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS
FOR REGISTRATION AS OPERATORS UNDER THE LAW
REGULATING THE OCCUPATION OF HAIRDRESSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eighty-seven Z of chapter one hundred and
2 twelve of the General Laws, as most recently amended
3 by section five of chapter three hundred and eighty-
4 five of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-seven,
5 is hereby further amended by striking out, in the
6 eleventh and twelfth lines, the words, or in a school
7 in this commonwealth supported by public funds, —
8 so as to read as follows: — *Section 87Z.* The board
9 may register, without examination, any hairdresser,
10 operator or manicurist who has been registered as
11 such under the laws of another state which, in the
12 opinion of the board, maintains a standard sub-
13 stantially equivalent to that of this commonwealth,

14 and in which hairdressers, operators and manicurists
15 registered in this commonwealth are given like rec-
16 ognition, upon payment of a fee of twenty dollars,
17 in the case of a hairdresser, fifteen dollars in the case
18 of an operator, and five dollars in the case of a mani-
19 curist. Any person who has completed in another
20 state a course of professional training, substantially
21 equivalent to that required by section eighty-seven V,
22 and who, after application accompanied by an exam-
23 ination fee of five dollars for a first examination or
24 three dollars for a second or subsequent examination,
25 passes an examination satisfactory to the board, may
26 be registered by the board as an operator.
