AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE PLACING OF THE OFFICE OF CITY ENGINEER OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The office of city engineer of the city  
2 of Holyoke shall, upon the effective date of this act,  
3 become subject to the civil service laws, rules and  
4 regulations, and the tenure of office of any incumbent  
5 thereof shall be unlimited, subject, however, to said  
6 laws, but the person holding said office on said effective  
7 date may continue therein without taking a civil  
8 service examination.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
