AN ACT PROVIDING HIGHER EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE CHILDREN OF MASSACHUSETTS MEN WHO DIED IN THE MILITARY OR NAVAL SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES DURING THE WORLD WAR, OR AS A RESULT OF SUCH SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter two hundred and sixty-three of the acts of
2 nineteen hundred and thirty is hereby amended by
3 striking therefrom section two of said act and sub-
4 stituting therefor the following:—

5 *Section 2.* Any child who is eligible under the
6 provisions of the preceding section, shall, upon be-
7 coming a student in any educational institution
8 approved in writing by the commissioner of educa-
9 tion, be entitled to reimbursement by the common-
10 wealth, in an amount not to exceed two hundred and
11 fifty dollars in any year for expenses for tuition, board

12 and room rent, transportation, books and supplies
13 necessary or incidental to his or her pursuit of study
14 at any such approved educational institution. Such
15 reimbursement shall be made to such child or his
16 guardian, if any, on the presentation of vouchers
17 therefor approved by the said commissioner.
